
## Give Healthy life to BPH patients...

## Benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH)

is the most common cause of LUTS in elderly men over 70 years of age.





- Selective alpha 1-A receptor antagonist which are primarily located on bladder neck and urethra.
- Works by relaxing muscles in the prostate and bladder, helps to improve urine flow and reduce symptoms of BPH acts as an a₁-adrenoceptor antagonist with high uroselectivity (selectivity for the prostate).



Alfa-blockers are now considered as **first-line drugs** in the medical management of BPH
